VOTE BY MAIL



Mail ballots are Safe, Secure, and Counted in every election.

To vote by mail, request your ballot by contacting the elections office online or by phone at:

HamiltonVotesFL.gov

Vote-by-Mail ballots must be received by elections office no later than 7:00 PM on election day, August 23rd.

If you choose to mail your ballot, the Post Office recommends that you mail it at least one week before Election Day.

Enclosed are **SAMPLE BALLOTS** for the **AUGUST 23, 2022 - PRIMARY ELECTION** and are for informational purposes only. This is not an "Official" ballot - please do not return it to the elections office. Please study your sample ballot before you go to vote.

You may take it to the polls and use it as a guide when voting.

Florida is a Closed Primary State

Only voters who are registered members of political parties may vote for respective candidates for an office in a primary election.

However, there are times when all registered voters can vote in a primary election, regardless of which political party they are registered with or even if they are registered without party affiliation:

1. When a Universal Primary Contest occurs: if all the candidates for an office have the same party affiliation and the winner of the primary election will not face any opposition in the general election, then all registered voters can vote for any of the candidates for that office in the primary election.
2. If races for nonpartisan (i.e., free from party affiliation) judicial and school board offices, nonpartisan special districts or referendum questions are on the primary election ballot, then all registered voters, including those without party affiliation are entitled to vote those races on the ballot.

DEADLINE for the August 23, 2022 - **PRIMARY ELECTION**
to **REGISTER TO VOTE** and **MAKE ANY PARTY CHANGES** is **JULY 25, 2022.**

SECURE BALLOT INTAKE STATION (formerly known as DROP BOX)

Due to the passage of Senate Bill 90, 2021 and Senate Bill 524, 2022, the ballot intake station, that can be used for returning Vote-by-Mail Ballots, will only be available inside your Supervisor of Elections Office during normal business hours and during early voting hours.



Has Your Signature Changed?

Signatures are compared against the voter's record to verify county petitions, vote-by mail ballots, and provisional ballots.

If you believe your signature has changed you must submit a Florida Voter Registration Application.

Our tabulation system uses an optical scanner to read your ballot. You must completely fill in the oval for your vote to count.
