



“I Voted” Sticker Design Contest

(Open to all school age children in Hamilton County)

The Contest: It’s simple – design a new “I Voted” sticker for Hamilton County voters. The first-place winning design will be reproduced and given to voters who vote in the 2022 Election cycle. The art will also be featured online, displayed at our office, local libraries and in other outreach locations in an effort to encourage our community to vote.

The Rules: Use your imagination and creativity. Your artwork must be two-dimensional, and round. Keep in mind that the winning artwork must be clear and impactful when reduced to a 2” x 2” size for sticker printing. **The art must be nonpartisan and may not promote any party, candidate, or issue.** All artwork must be original and may not include any copyrighted images. The artwork can be created on the accompanying template or using your own materials.

- Designs must say “I Voted”
- Submissions must be non-partisan.
- Students should consider elements representative of Hamilton County, elections, or patriotism.
- Students and/or parents must be willing to allow the use of the artwork for 2022 elections.
- Fill out and sign the submission form (signed by a parent if under 18)
- Entries may include a short description of the design or information on the inspiration for the design.
- Entries will be accepted from now until Friday, May 13,2022.

Copyrighted characters, product logos, trademarked or brand names cannot be used.

Provide either digital submissions to elects@hamiltonvotes.com or hand deliver an original paper submission by **Friday, May 13,2022.**

The winner will be announced at the end of May 2022.

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Format:

ALL DIGITAL SUBMISSIONS MUST:

- Be original
- Be saved so you can later export with crop and bleed marks and color information

Note: For digital submissions, we may require you to send the packaged design files if your design is chosen.

PAPER SUBMISSIONS MUST:

- Be original
- Be on white paper – template is located here
- Can be created with crayon, markers, or paint (watercolor, tempera, acrylic)

The “I VOTED” Sticker Contest is an opportunity for students to participate in a conversation about civic engagement in a creative way. Each piece of art is judged on the following criteria:

- The artist followed directions outlined in guidelines (medium, size, general theme, etc.).
- The art is appealing.
- The art is non-partisan
- The graphics are balanced, striking and original.

When it comes to displaying artwork on the Supervisor of Elections’ website and on reproductions of the art in election publications, the Supervisor of Elections reserves the right to not judge or display an entry for reasons that may include, but are not limited to: misspellings, inaccurate information, candidate or political favoritism.

- \$25 Gift card

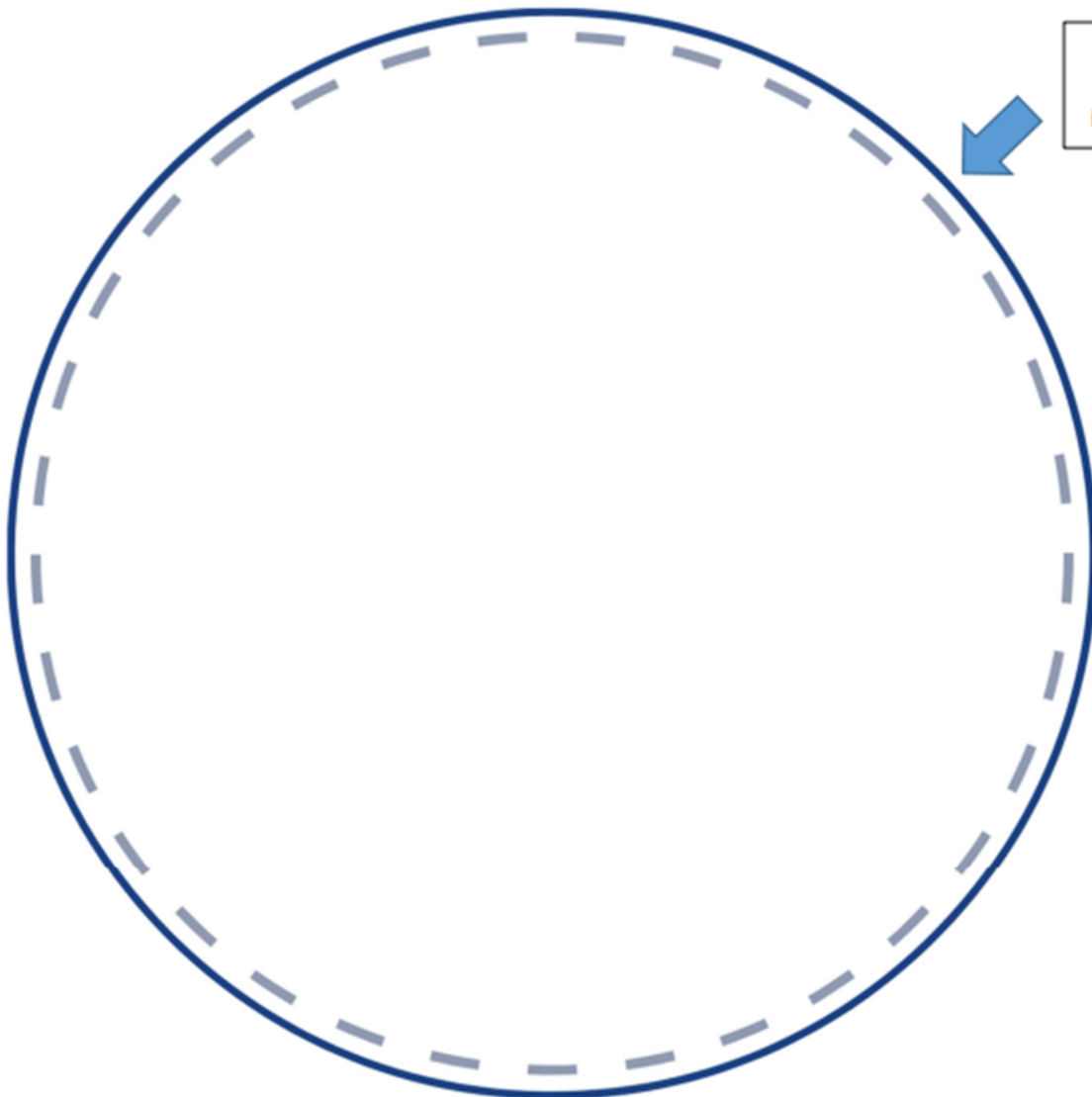
